Winners will be announced at Veteran's Park after the parade!

- **No live Santa's on floats!** Only ONE (1) Santa will be allowed in the Parade; he will ride at the end.
 - Please maintain the appropriate distance between your unit and the next. Stop in front of the judge's stand for no more than fifteen (15) seconds.
 - Parade numbers will be given out right before the start of the parade and must be clearly visible on the driver's side of the entry.
 - Sirens and horn are not prohibited while lining up and waiting in line.
 - Walkers **MUST NOT** walk back through the parade route, but may use any of the side streets.
 - Once lined up, motorized vehicles must remain parked until instructed to move.
 - **Candy may not be thrown from floats or vehicles.**
 - Children on floats and in marching units should be supervised by the appropriate number of adults at all times.
 - **Each float must have 4 safety walkers with flashlights around the perimeter at all times.**
 - Each unit is responsible for cleaning up their staging area, as well as along the parade route, if necessary.
 - If at any time leading up to the parade day, the weather or street conditions are determined to be unsafe, the parade will be cancelled.  - No alcohol allowed.
 - The Chamber of Commerce reserves the right to reject any parade entry deemed inappropriate or unsafe.

PARADE ROUTE – LINE UP AT STADIUM HOME SIDE (Bois d'Arc Street)) – TRAVELING WEST ON MABLE STREET TO 4TH STREET, TURN NORTH ON 4TH TO COLLEGE STREET, TURN WEST ON COLLEGE STREET, GO WEST TO 2ND STREET AND TURN SOUTH, TAKE 2ND TO MABLE AND HEAD BACK EAST ON MABLE TO STADIUM AGAIN.
